Hi all,

I hope everyone is getting more flying in than I am. I think I have been out maybe 3 times, so far this season. Hopefully, conditions will improve for us weekend fliers, and we can get some stick time in. The field should be in good shape. We had it sprayed for weeds along with a shot of fertilizer so, last I heard, it was looking pretty good. The new sign is up as well - thank you to those who assisted in that effort. The sign looks good, and the updated rules are now posted.

Our first flying event of the season is fast approaching, June 17th, is the 22nd Annual Scale Meet. Same rules as always: planes need to be scale(ish) models of real airplanes to be entered and must fly to be eligible for the trophies, but all registered pilots are eligible for prizes whether they fly or not. Same classes as before, Sport Class and Giant Class for those with a wingspan over 80". Best of Show will be awarded as well. Jets have a formula to calculate where they belong, but generally will end up in the giant class. Please make sure that the planes have flown safely before the scale meet, as the meet is no place for maiden flights. We hopefully will have a large crowd of spectators and, due to safety concerns, maidens are not allowed at the event. So, you have a little over a week to get em dialed in!! We will need some help with set up on the Friday before the event, watch your e-mails for details on the time, etc. On the day of the event, I will need help with the flight line as always. If lots of folks can pitch in for an hour or so, then it is not overly taxing for anyone. We will have the Johnnie's Meat Market Food Truck there for lunch again. This is the same folks who were there last year and, if you didn't try the brisket sandwich, you missed out!! We will hammer out details at the meeting on Monday.

For those who did not already heard, the FAA rule requiring us to register with the FAA and put the FAA # on our planes was shot down in court. The court basically said that the FAA violated the law that was passed that forbids the FAA from imposing new rules on model aviation. A win to be sure, but I would bet the fight is not over yet. The ruling took effect immediately so registration is no longer required.
